Subject : Business sector can now issue an E-Tax invoice

Today (24th December 2012) Dr. Satit Rungkasiri, Director-General of the Revenue Department and Mr. Teera Aphaiwong, President of Thai Digital ID Co., Ltd. signed the memorandum of understanding on digital certificate service for e-Tax Invoice and e-Receipt issuance. On this occasion, the executives of two organizations, together with press joined as the witnesses at Pra-utain Conference room 5, the Revenue Department building.

Dr. Satit Rungkasiri, Director-General of the Revenue Department, revealed that “The technological advance nowadays permits the entrepreneur to establish the business everywhere and transactions via Internet are more favorable than traditional commerce. Computer use can reduce cost of paper and space of storage for entrepreneur. In addition, the Revenue Department can save time in providing a data into system and increase effectiveness of tax administration. Therefore, the Revenue Department has tried to promote electronic transaction such as e-tax return filing. **Today is one of our better steps to permit the entrepreneur to be able to issue e-Tax Invoice instead of paper invoice. For security, the Revenue Department uses technology on safe identification by digital certificate as well”**
