Subject: Tax exemption for income of disabled persons

Ms. Jitrmanee Suwannapool, the Deputy Director-General as the Revenue Department's spokesperson, has revealed that "assessable income of a resident of Thailand who is registered as a disabled person under the Persons with Disabilities Empowerment Act B.E.2550 will be exempt from income tax up to 190,000 baht. Nevertheless, he or she must hold a disability identification card and must be 65 years old or under in the tax year. The purpose of the law is to improve the quality of life for over 1.2 millions of people with disabilities in the countrywide who are liable to pay tax"
