Subject : The Revenue Department is aiming to develop Thai young generation
by the project **"You are a good citizen with tax compliance"**

Today (28th February 2013) **Dr. Satit Rungkasiri**, Director-General of the Revenue Department stated in the press release of the project **"You are a good citizen with tax compliance"** aiming to use the aesthetics of music to develop Thai young generation to have social responsibility with the musical instruments derived from the tax of Thai people at Lobby 1st Floor, the Revenue Department Building.

Dr. Satit Rungkasiri, Director-General of the Revenue Department revealed that "the project **"You are a good citizen with tax compliance"** is an event that the Revenue Department has continued for many years. The budget is allocated from tax of Thai people to return benefits to the Thai society. For this year, the policy is to support musical instruments for the school that needs them to develop potential of the children and open an opportunity for Thai young generation to have access and to have music appreciation aiming to create moral and social responsibility in the concept of **'music builds a good kid'** and look forward to implant the social values to have a tax compliance. Therefore, the interested schools are welcome to apply to the project from now until 15th March 2556 more details are available at www.rd.go.th. The school selected will receive musical instruments and 2 days - 1 night training program of 'magic **five** notes sound' which is simple enough for children at basic level. It can be applied to any instrument and widely used in the folk music of many nations. These **5** notes will be the questions for children to develop their skills (with teacher recommendation), which will make the creative brain work better and more efficiently."

In the press conference, Apart from the 'magic five notes sound' show there also be a discussion on the topic of **'Music for Youth Development'** by **Dr. Satit Rungkasiri**, Director-General of the Revenue Department, **Dr. Udom Petchsungharn** (specialist in the child brain development), **Ms. Nuanpan Lumsum** (President of the social responsibility and quality of life Committee, the Thai Chamber of Commerce and Managing Director of MuangThai Insurance Public Company Limited), and **Mr. Saharat Sungkapreecha** (member of the Nouveau band and an adjudicator in The Voice Thailand).

'Magic five notes sound' which is the key in the project “You are a good citizen with tax compliance” as the Revenue Department aims to enhance the development of young people learning to grow steadily to be a good citizen of Thailand to create a sustainable tax base and keep pace with this globalizing world.
