**Subject** : Personal Income Tax exemption for Government Officers in the Southern border provinces

The Revenue Department informed that government officers who are working in the Southern border provinces are eligible for Personal Income Tax exemption on special earnings. This is the incentive for those who work in risk areas as under the unusual circumstances and the exemption is effective for the assessable income received on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012.

Ms. Jitmanee Suwannapool, Principal Advisor on Tax Base Management, as the Revenue Department Spokesperson, said that "The Revenue Department implements an tax measure in order to help the government officers who are working in the Southern border provinces, for examples: Narathiwat province, Pattani province, Yala province, Satun province and some districts of Songkhla province, such as Tapa, Sabayoy, Natawee, and Jana. Personal Income Tax exemption on special earnings under the Compensation Act 2007 will benefit officers working in the Southern border provinces for assessable income derived on or after 1<sup>st</sup> January 2012."
