Subject : The Revenue Department affirms that information of people who registered on

www.<u>raomaithingkun.com</u> will not be used for tax audit

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, the Revenue Department's Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) and spokeswoman, said, "there has been a misconception that the Revenue Department will use the information of self-employed individuals who registered on www.raomaithingkun.com ("Nobody will be left behind" in Thai) for backdated tax audit. The Revenue Department is fully aware that taxpayers and the general public are facing challenging times due to the coronavirus pandemic. Recently, the Department has introduced 12 tax measures to alleviate impacts of those affected by the outbreak, especially tax measures for personal income tax including deferral of tax filing deadline from 31st March 2020 to 31st August 2020, tax exemption for extra income which healthcare and medical workers receive from the Ministry of Health in 2020 in compensation for working with COVID-19 patients, and increase of health insurance premiums deduction from 15,000 baht to 25,000 baht."

The Revenue Department affirms that information of individuals who registered on for the cash handout will not be used for tax audit; therefore, please do not be concerned about your information. The Department is sending love and compassionate support to all Thais to get through this storm together.
