Subject : The Revenue Department announced the provider of downtown Value added tax Refund for Tourists (VRT) service

From 7th to 17th September 2018, The Revenue Department opened to the public the application for providing downtown VAT Refund for Tourists (VRT) service under the six-month pilot project which runs from 1st October 2018 to 31st March 2019.

The Revenue Department received three applications and granted approval to Counter Service Co., Ltd. The company will offer the VRT service at three locations: 7-11 Lido Cinema, 7-11 Bangkok Night Bazaar, and 7-11 Padung Dao. The pilot project will run for six months from 1st October 2018 to 31st March 2019. The Revenue Department will then evaluate the project and report to the Ministry of Finance to decide whether the initiative should be permanent. The Revenue Department has provided information on downtown VRT on its official website www.rd.go.th/vrt and the selected downtown VRT agent will publicize further information to tourists.
