Subject	: Corporate income tax return filing for accounting period 2019 ends on 31 <sup>st</sup> August 2020

The Revenue Department would like to thank all taxpayers for filing corporate income tax returns. For those who have not filed tax returns yet, please file your tax return by 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020. We suggest you to file tax returns via our website www.rd.go.th. In case taxpayers are eligible to receive tax refund, "Promptpay" is the most convenient channel to get the refund.

Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) and spokesperson of the Revenue Department, revealed that, "As the COVID-19 pandemic has a major impact on businesses across sectors, the Revenue Department has extended the deadline for corporate income tax return filing (P.N.D.50 or P.N.D.55) for accounting period 2019 to 31<sup>st</sup> August 2020. Statistics as of 17<sup>th</sup> August 2020, 313,262 taxpayers have filed corporate income tax returns whereas 258,898 taxpayers have not. Based on last year corporate income tax return filing for accounting period 2018 statistics, there are 572,160 taxpayers who have filed tax returns. According to our "TAX from Home" project, we would like to encourage taxpayers to use our electronic services at www.rd.go.th. The services include e-Registration, e-Filing, e-Payment, and e-Refund. The objectives of the services are to prevent the spread of COVID-19 and for taxpayers' convenience."

The Revenue Department spokesperson added, "TAX from home is convenient for taxpayers and keeps social distancing by submitting documents online, avoiding physical interaction and touching cash or cheque. Therefore, we suggest taxpayers to use our electronic services from TAX from home project so as to be safe from COVID-19 pandemic."
