Subject : The Revenue Department has launched a new kind of tax education service via website

The Revenue Department has launched the new online tax education service to make taxpayers, entrepreneurs and the public understand tax law and how to use the new electronic services of the Revenue Department.

(Energy Industry) as spokesperson of the Revenue Department, revealed that “The Revenue Department focuses on tax literacy by stressing on building knowledge and understanding about taxation of taxpayers, entrepreneurs and the public. Therefore, under the situation of COVID-19, the Revenue Department has complied with the social distancing principles and adopted a webinar by compiling online seminars in the format of the TAX Station program to update tax knowledge combined with knowledge from partners.
