**Subject** : The Revenue Department reminds companies and juristic partnerships about the deadline for filing the 2020 semi-annual corporate income tax returns (P.N.D. 51) within 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020

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The Revenue Department has announced that 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020 is the end of the extended deadline for filing semi-annual corporate income tax returns (P.N.D. 51) for non-listed companies and juristic partnerships. Filing tax returns on-time will help taxpayers not to pay surcharge and fine.

**Mrs. Sommai Siriudomset, Principal Advisor on Strategic Tax Administration (Energy Industry) as spokesperson of the Revenue Department,** revealed that “the extended deadline for filing semi-annual corporate income tax returns (P.N.D. 51) is on 30<sup>th</sup> September 2020. This is a tax measure expecting to help the entrepreneurs to increase their financial and operating liquidity. The Revenue Department has encouraged taxpayers to file their tax returns (P.N.D. 51) via [www.rd.go.th](http://www.rd.go.th) and make tax payments via participated bank which will make any tax transactions convenient and easy for the entrepreneurs. In case that taxpayers fail to file and pay tax within the deadline, a maximum fine of 2,000 Baht will be imposed upon any late filings and an additional surcharge of 1.5 percent per month in the case where there are taxes to be paid.”
